



PROVINCIAL PEST CONTROL

COCKROACH PREP SHEET

Preparation of a room for treatment is essential to the successful management of Cockroaches. The most common cockroach in Alberta is called the (German Cockroach). It can be found inside and outside. With an average length of 15mm for a fully grown adult. Females can be found carrying the eggs on her back. Keeping a clean environment will help in the eradication, and control of these bugs.

Suggested room preparation steps include:

- Pull out **Deep Freeze, Fridge, and Stoves.**
- Clear anything that may be in the exterminators way.
- Put ***ANY OPEN FOOD, (INCLUDING BOXED FOOD) PUT IN PLASTIC, SEALED CONTAINERS.*** This will help eliminate any food sources, allowing for best results.
- Move Furniture at least 18 inches away from the walls. People may need help with this.
- People and pets must leave the area during treatment and wait the stated amount of time before re-entering, usually 4 hours.
- If there is a fish tank in the household, it should be covered with a towel or plastic, because fish are very sensitive to many pesticides
- Make sure the pest control professional can get to all furniture, closets, sinks, beds, and baseboards to inspect and treat.
